## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-29**

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING HF773, FORMERLY HSB165, A PROPERTY TAX REFORM BILL UNDER CONSIDERATION IN THE IOWA LEGISLATURE; WITHIN THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, BUCHANAN COUNTY, IOWA.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Independence believes that, in the spirit of Home Rule, city budgeting and spending is best left in the hands of locally elected governments;

WHEREAS, the City of Independence is a growing city that takes great care to provide the highest quality city services while remaining committed to conservative spending and responsible fund balances;

WHEREAS, increasing city taxes are often the result of state mandates, such as pension contributions, and commercial and multi-residential property tax rollbacks;

WHEREAS, each city has unique needs, goals and priorities such that uniform caps are not appropriate; and,

WHEREAS, the property tax reform bill under consideration was developed with little input from stakeholders and may result in unintended consequences damaging to the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, IOWA, the City of Independence remains committed to keeping taxes low and providing great value to its citizens, but opposes HF773 as follows:

The City opposes limitations on the authority of locally elected officials;

The City opposes proposed caps on property tax revenue growth;

The City opposes proposed caps on ending fund balances;

The City opposes limitations on the permitted use of the Trust and Agency Levy for costs of pensions and employee health insurance.
