

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-518

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 70.02 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, IOWA TO INCLUDE A SCHEDULE OF FINES FOR VIOLATIONS DETECTED BY AN AUTOMATED TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT SYSTEM

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, IOWA:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Ordinance 70.02, adopted the 13th day of January, 2020, to include a schedule of fines for violations detected by an Automated Traffic Enforcement System.

Section 2. Amendment. Ordinance 70.02 is hereby amended and replaced as follows:

70.02 Scheduled Violations.

1. For violations of the traffic Code that are designated by Section 805.8A of the *Code of Iowa* to be scheduled violations, the scheduled fine for each of those violations shall be as specified in Section 805.8A of the *Code of Iowa*, except those violations detected by an Automated Traffic Enforcement System, as set forth in Chapter 71 of this Code of Ordinances.

2. For violations detected by an Automated Traffic Enforcement System, the schedule of fines as set out in the Fines and Fee Schedule (Section 1.15 of this Code of Ordinances)

Speeding Violation

10-15 miles per hours over the posted speed limit	\$ 75.00
16-20 miles per hours over the posted speed limit	\$ 100.00
More than 21 miles per hour over the posted speed limit	\$ 200.00

Speed Violation (School Zone)

6-10 miles per hour over the posted speed limit	\$ 75.00
11-15 miles per hours over the posted speed limit	\$ 100.00
16-20 miles per hours over the posted speed limit	\$ 125.00
More than 21 miles per hour over the posted speed limit	\$ 225.00

Section 3. Rescission. Except for the language of 70.02 specifically amended by this Ordinance, all remaining portions of 70.02, as previously adopted, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Severability Clause. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.


Section 5. Repealer. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
